<b>E-Prescribing</b>	Compulink's Advantage software has a built in e-prescribing module that is fully certified with Surescript creating a seamless and direct bridge to allow providers to send prescriptions electronically to pharmacies. Features include direct submission to the pharmacy via electronic transfer or fax, and interactive checking for drug to drug, drug to allergy, and drug to diagnosis, on-line insurance formulary, eligibility, and history. <b>Direct Secure Messaging</b>	Compulink's Advantage software allows users to exchange health information with other health care entities (e.g. primary care physicians, specialists, hospitals, clinical labs) in a trusted network. Direct functions like regular e-mail with additional security measures, such as point to point encryption and electronic security certificates. Using Direct ensures that messages sent and received are only accessible to the intended recipient, per the protection regulations of the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA). <b>Patient Health Portal</b>	The Advantage Patient Portal enables patients and patient-authorized entities, such as referring physicians, to securely access their protected health information. Compulink utilizes Continuity of Care Documents (CCDs) to provide a complete and continuously updated clinical summary of the patient's care, including an active problem list, medications, allergies, and laboratory test results. In addition to the clinical summary, personalized educational resources, appropriate to the patient's conditions and care plan, are uploaded and available via electronic links on the secure Portal. <b>PHI Export</b>	PHI Exports allows a user to export a complete patient demographic, billing, and medical history data set. This can be done per patient, all patients, or a subset based on location or staff groups. <b>Public Health Reporting Interfaces and Health Information Exchanges</b>	A number of registry options are available within Compulink. Most can be generated right in the patient's exam. Compulink will assist in making sure the data generated – whether the 3 <sup>rd</sup> party follows the standard or needs customization based on the needs of the state – we will make sure it gets to the end point. <b>Other interoperability solutions including HL7 connections</b>	Health Level Seven is an accredited Standards Developing Organization (SDO) which was created to facilitate interoperability between computer systems that exchange health care data. Using a standard HL7 Message format, systems that otherwise could not communicate are able to share information. Message Types: Compulink offers both outbound (you send the messages) and inbound (you receive the messages) HL7 interfaces. Compulink has interfaced with dozens of vendors and are very capable of creating custom interfaces should the 3 <sup>rd</sup> party not follow a standardized format or need custom alterations and data.
